Command Sgt. Maj. Jeremiah E. Inman assumed duties as U.S. Army Europe and Africa's Command Sergeant Major January 2022.

Command Sgt. Maj. Inman began his career as a Soldier in 1987, after completing infantry basic training at Fort Benning, Georgia.

During the course of his career, he has held numerous duty positions, including: rifleman, gunner, team leader, section leader, platoon sergeant and first sergeant, tactical operations noncommissioned officer, brigade tactical department sergeant major, airborne infantry brigade operations sergeant major, and squadron command sergeant major.

He also served as command sergeant major, 197th Infantry Brigade; command sergeant major, 316th Cavalry Brigade; command sergeant major, U.S. Army Infantry School; Airborne and Special Operations Test Directorate sergeant major; command sergeant major, Joint Readiness Training Center and Fort Polk; command sergeant major, U.S. Army Africa, Caserma Ederle; command sergeant major, Combined Transition Security Command – Afghanistan; and senior enlisted advisor, Resolute Support, Kabul, Afghanistan.
