Brig. Gen. Jed J. Schaertl is originally from Shortsville, New York. He assumed his position at U.S. Army Europe and Africa in September 2020.

He was commissioned from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1991 as an engineer. In his most recent assignment, he served as deputy commanding general, 108th Training Command (Initial Entry Training).

He previously served in Germany in leadership positons with the 54th Engineer Battalion (Combat) (Mechanized), Wildflecken, and the 10th Engineer Battalion (Combat) (Mechanized), Schweinfurt.
