





# Atlantic Resolve

Atlantic Resolve provides rotational deployments of combat-credible forces to Europe to show our commitment to NATO while building readiness, increasing interoperability and enhancing the bonds between ally and partner militaries.

## 1 Division Headquarters (Forward)

Currently: 1st Infantry Division (as of July 2021)

- Division-level tactical headquarters
- Responsible for mission command of Regionally Allocated Forces
- Located in Poznan, Poland
- Oversees U.S. Army Europe and Africa's operations on NATO's eastern flank

## 2 Aviation Rotation

Currently: 1st Combat Aviation Brigade, 1st Infantry Division (as of March 2021)

- +1800 Wheeled Vehicles + Equipment
- 25 AH-64 Apaches
- 10 CH-47 Chinooks
- 50 UH-60/HH-60 Black Hawks

## 3 Armored Rotation

Currently: 1st Armored Brigade Combat Team, 1st Infantry Division (as of July 2021)

- +500 Tracked Vehicles
- +1500 Wheeled Vehicles + Equipment
- 80 Abrams tanks
- 15 Paladins
- 130 Bradleys

## 4 Logistics Rotation

from 11 Active Duty Reserve & National Guard Units

Also known as the Sustainment Task Force. Provides various logistical support to include supplies, maintenance, postal, fuel and feeding.
