

EES ENTRY/ EXIT SYSTEM INFORMATION

UNOFFICIAL TRAVEL

i.e., vacations within EU countries

ALL PERSONNEL AND DEPENDENTS MUST HAVE PROPER SOFA IDENTIFICATION ON THEM.

ACTIVE-DUTY: bring CAC, PCS Orders & NATO Orders to your European country, leave form, and tourist passport. Use all documents (except the tourist passport) when leaving Germany; use the tourist passport when entering and leaving the short-stay EU country of destination; then use all documents (except the tourist passport) when returning to Germany.

DOD CIVILIANS, FAMILY MEMBERS: Bring both passports - Special Issuance Passport (SIP) and tourist passport. Use the SIP when leaving Germany; use the tourist passport when entering and leaving the short-stay EU country of destination; then use the SIP when returning to Germany.



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The exception from registration in the EES applies to members of the armed forces traveling on NATO or Partnership for Peace business, who hold an identification and individual or collective movement order provided for by the Agreement between the parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regarding the status of their forces and may apply to civilian component or dependents referred to in the NATO Status of Forces Agreement.

Active Duty

Show DoD ID & orders (including NATO orders) - no passport needed for NATO countries

Family Members of Active-Duty

Bring sponsor's PCS orders + Blue Special Issuance Passport (SIP)

DoD Civilians

Bring Maroon SIP + PCS orders

Family Members of DoD Civilians

Bring sponsor's orders + Maroon SIP



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
